

Terms and Conditions of the Global Atomic Quiz International Educational Project

1. General

These Terms and Conditions outline the procedure and timeframes for the international educational Project “Global Atomic Quiz” (hereinafter the “Project”). They cover the participation and the winners selection process. The Project aims to increase public knowledge of nuclear physics and educate people worldwide about the latest world achievements in the nuclear industry and the benefits of the peaceful nuclear technology use. The Project target audience (hereinafter the “Participants”): anyone from around the world who meets the requirements and follows these Terms and Conditions. By participating in the Project, the Participants fully accept these Terms and Conditions (hereinafter the “Terms and Conditions”). The Project is governed by these Terms and Conditions. It is a non-profit outreach initiative, not a promotion event or lottery.

Basic Details

- 1.1. Title: international educational project “Global Atomic Quiz”.
- 1.2. The Project is hosted on the website www.quiz.atomforyou.com and can be accessed from anywhere without any geographical restrictions. The Project is subject to the laws of the Russian Federation.
- 1.3. The Project Organizer: the Autonomous Non-Profit Organization for the Development of Information Centers for Atomic Energy “Energy of the Future” (ANO Energy of the Future), TIN 7726385219, TRRC 772601001, address: 117105, Russian Federation, Moscow, Varshavskoe shosse, 3 (hereinafter referred to as the "Organizer").
- 1.4. Project period:
 - 1.4.1. The total Project period runs from November 10, 2024, to the date the prizes are awarded to the winners, or December 31, 2024, whichever comes first. This period includes the time Participants spend taking part in the Project, the time the Organizer needs to select the winners, and the time it takes to award the Prizes to the Winners based on the Project results.
 - 1.4.2. The Project main period: Participants will take the Quiz, which tests their basic knowledge of nuclear physics and world nuclear achievements, at any time from 00:00:00 on November 10, 2024 to 23:59:59 on November 10, 2024 (local time).
 - 1.4.3. The Project’s results will be summarized and winners announced by November 22, 2024, at the latest.
 - 1.4.4. The period for awarding Prizes to winners based on their participation in the Project as per the Terms and Conditions is from November 30, 2024 to December 31, 2024.
 - 1.4.5. The Organizer will notify Project participants separately about the exact dates for issuing the Prizes, which will be determined later.
 - 1.4.6. The Organizer reserves the right to change the timeframes specified in clauses 1.4.3. – 1.4.5. of the Terms and Conditions.
 - 1.4.7. If the Organizer is unable to award the Prizes to the winners due to circumstances beyond their control such as force majeure, natural disasters, or restrictions on international mail), the Project Participants will be notified. In this case, the Organizer reserves the right to either cancel the Prize transfer or modify the issuance schedule at their discretion.
- 1.5. Ways of informing the Participants: The Terms and Conditions, Project timeframes, and results of the will be published on the Project’s Website: quiz.atomforyou.com, which will include all language versions (hereinafter the "Website").
- 1.6. Initial contact with the Participants and/or with their parents/legal representatives, which includes verifying their data and identity documents, will only be made from the Project’s email address: info@atomforyou.com.

2. Participants and Participation Conditions

- 2.1. People from any country can take part in the Project competition if they fill out the registration form and give us their consent to process personal data on the Project Website. If individuals do not register, they can still participate, but they will not be eligible for the competition.
- 2.2. Minor Participants who cannot act independently due to their country's national legislation, but instead perform these Terms and Conditions through their parents (or legal representatives) or with their assistance.
- 2.2.1. Parents of legal representatives of minor Participants are responsible for reviewing these Terms and Conditions and providing the necessary consents, as required by national laws, for their child's participation in the Project and the use of their personal data.
- 2.2.2. The Organizer presumes that minor Participants act with the consent of their parents or legal when taking part in the Project, and that these actions comply with national laws.
- 2.2.3. The Organizer has the right to exclude a minor Participant from the Project if it finds out that their parents or legal representatives have not given the required consent.
- 2.3. The following individuals are not eligible to participate in the Project's competition:
- Employees of the Organizer, individuals representing the Organizer, their family members;
 - Third-party employees and representatives with a contractual relationship to the Organizer and associated with the Project, as well as their family members;
 - Employees and representatives of Rosatom companies.
- 2.4. The Project Participants have the right to receive Project information as outlined in these Terms and Conditions.
- 2.5. The Project Participants shall have the following responsibilities:
- To comply with the Terms and Conditions throughout their participation in the Project;
 - To provide the Organizer with accurate and truthful information about themselves in accordance with the Terms and Conditions;
 - To fulfill any additional responsibilities specified in these Terms and Conditions.

3. Project Participation Procedure and Winners Selection.

- 3.1. The Winners will be determined based on the competitive part of the Project, and in accordance with the Project Terms and Conditions, they will receive Prizes from the Organizer (hereinafter the Prizes).
- 3.2. To participate in the competitive part of the Project, the Participant must fill out the registration form on the Website.
- 3.2.1. To register on the Website the applicants must provide the following information:
- First and last names;
 - Date of birth;
 - E-mail address;
 - Country of residence; Mark of consent to participate in the Project and to the personal data processing.
- 3.2.2. The Organizer reserves the right to deny participation in the competitive part of the Project to Participants who submit incomplete or inaccurate registration forms. Once registered, Participant cannot change their email address entered on the Website during registration.
- 3.3. Winners will be selected as follows:
- 3.3.1. Registered Participants must complete the Quiz tasks that test their knowledge of nuclear physics basics and world achievements in the nuclear industry.

- 3.3.1.1. The Quiz is held online at quiz.atomforyou.com, which includes all language versions.
- 3.3.1.2. The Quiz features 20 questions about nuclear topics and world achievements, ranging from simple to complex. The Participant must choose the correct answer from the options provided by the system.
- 3.3.1.3. Each Participant can only answer the Quiz questions once. If someone takes the Quiz multiple times, they won't be eligible for the competition.
- 3.3.1.4. The participant can move on to the next question after answering the previous one.
- 3.3.1.5. The response time for each Quiz task will be tracked with a timer. The speed at which all tasks are completed will affect the Participant's final score, which determines their ranking in the Winners rating.
- 3.3.1.6. The Winners are automatically rated based on their number of correct answers and quiz completion speed. The more points a Participant earns, the higher their ranking position will be.
- 3.3.2. The Participant's final score is made up of the following components:
 - 3.3.2.1. The weight of correct answers varies by rubric: "True or False", and "Your Version" each award 1 point per correct answer, while "In order" awards 1 point for one match, 2 point for two matches, and 4 points for four matches.
 - 3.3.2.2. When calculating the final score of the Participant, the speed at which they complete the Quiz tasks is also considered. Each question has a time factor, which depends on how quickly the Participant responds to it.
 - 3.3.2.3. The higher is the Participant's final score, the higher their position in the Participants' ranking.
 - 3.3.2.4. If several Participants have the same score, the one who finished the Quiz the fastest takes the higher place.
- 3.3.3. Winners approval:
 - 3.3.3.1. To ensure fair geographical representation among the Winners, the Organizer will select 100 Winners by 22 November 2024 based on the ranking of finalists and a country/region quota set by the Organizer. The quota for each country/region is determined by the Organizer after the Project is complete, proportionally to the total number of countries or regions represented by all Participants.
 - 3.3.3.2. The Organizer publishes a list of Winners on the Website no later than 12 calendar days after the end of the period specified in paragraph 1.4.2. of the Terms and Conditions. This list includes the Last Name, First Name, and identification number of each Winner. Additionally, the Winners will be notified by 2-mail.
 - 3.3.3.3. The Organizer contacts the Winners by e-mail to verify their compliance with the Participant requirements and the accuracy of their registration data. The Organizer then requests that the Winners sent their full name, date of birth, current residential address (including country, city, street, house, block, apartment, and postal code), and a contact phone number to the Project e-mail, which is necessary to arrange for the delivery of the Prizes.
 - 3.3.3.4. If the Winner fails to respond to the Organizer within four (4) calendar days after receiving the notification and/or if the Organizer has reasonable doubts about the accuracy of the Participant's data including cases where the email address does not match or the Participant provided false personal information, such as registering under a fake or someone else's name, the Winner's Prize will be cancelled and the Organizer will be entitled to select an alternative Winner according to the procedure outlined above.

4. Prizes for the Project Winners

4.1. All registered Participants will receive personal electronic certificates from the Project Organizer. The Participants who will take part without registering will get non-personalized electronic certificates.

4.2. The competitive part of the Project will have no more than 100 winners, chosen from the finalists based on the country or regional quota set by the Organizer.

4.3. The Winners of the Project's competitive part receive a Gift Set as their prize, which includes thematic products such as wooden puzzles that depict the main areas of nuclear energy application, worth up to 4,000 rubles (hereinafter the Prize).

4.3.1. Within 30 days after the period specified in paragraph 1.4.2. ends, the Organizer will send a letter to the Participant's email address, specifying the procedure for receiving the Prize and listing the necessary information and documents required to get it.

4.3.2. Prizes will be delivered to the Winner's provided address by post or in person, as decided by the Organizer. The Winner will be notified of the delivery method as part of the Prize receiving process.

The Organizer is not responsible if Prizes are not delivered to the Winner by the postal service. If a parcel is lost, the Participant cannot claim compensation for taking part in the Project.

4.4. The top three (3) Winners of the Project's competitive part, selected based on the rating of finalists according to the country/regional quota set by the Organizer, will be awarded a trip to Russian in 2024 as their Prize.

4.4.1. The Winners will be notified by email about the trip details, including conditions, date, time, and composition, using the email address provided during Website registration.

5. Miscellaneous

5.1. Any disputes or disagreements arising from the organization and implementation of the Project will be resolved through negotiations. If negotiations fail to settle a dispute, it will be resolved in court at the Organizer's location, in accordance with the Russian Federation's substantive and procedural law.

5.2. The Participants, parents, and/or legal representatives are responsible for covering the costs of obtaining all required documents and taking all necessary actions to participate in the Project.

5.3. All documents written by hand must be clear and easy to read. Scanned or photocopied documents must also be fully legible, or the Organizer may deem them unacceptable.

5.4. If the Organizer cannot transfer Prizes within the planned timeframe due to reasons beyond its control, it has the right to cancel or change the delivery timeframes as it sees fit. In such cases, the Participant is not entitled to demand any compensation related to their participation in the Project.

5.5. The Organizer has the right to bring in third parties to help carry out the Project and perform any actions related to it.
